

UPREHS Prime Medicare Part D Prescription Drug Plan 2010 Alternatives to Tier 3 Drugs

This list presents alternatives to the most often used nonpreferred Tier 3 drugs. Show this list to your doctor if you are currently using a Tier 3 drug and wish to replace it with a less expensive Tier 1 or 2 drug. Preferred Tier 1 and 2 drugs have lower copayments and use less of your Medicare benefits. How to use the Tier 3 Alternative list

Drugs are listed first by Therapeutic Category (medical condition) alphabetically and the drugs within the class are listed alphabetically by name. Drugs in capital letters are brand name drugs and those in small case letters are generic drugs.

- **TIER 3 NONPREFERRED DRUG NAME:** This is the name of the drug that is in the nonpreferred Tier 3.
- **TIER 1 GENERIC ALTERNATIVES:** Names of alternative Tier 1 generic preferred drugs.
- **TIER 2 BRAND NAME ALTERNATIVES:** Names of alternative Tier 2 brand name preferred drugs.
