

➤ **What do I need to know if I'm receiving extra help from Medicare to pay for my prescription drugs?**

If you get extra help from Medicare to help pay for your Medicare prescription drug plan costs, your monthly plan premium will be lower than what it would be if you did not get extra help from Medicare. The amount of extra help you get will determine your total monthly premium for both UPREHS Medicare Plans.

This table shows you what your monthly plan premium will be if you get extra help.

Your level of extra help	Combined 2009 Monthly Premium for the UPREHS Medicare Plans
100%	\$190.60
75%	\$197.90
50%	\$205.30
25%	\$212.60

You may receive (or have already received) a letter from Medicare, the Railroad Retirement Board, or the Social Security Administration (SSA) about your eligibility for extra help in 2009. Read this important information carefully. If you don't know what level of extra help you qualify for, you can call 1-800-MEDICARE (1-800-633-4227) for this information. TTY/TDD users should call 1-877-486-2048. They are available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. UPREHS does not make this determination and we receive the information from Medicare.

As an enhanced benefit, UPREHS offers additional coverage on some prescription drugs not normally covered in a Medicare Prescription Drug Plan. If you receive extra help from Medicare in paying for your drugs, you will NOT receive this extra help for these particular drugs. Please refer to the formulary being sent to you by separate mailing to see which drugs are covered by the enhanced benefit. Your copayment amounts for these drugs are dependent on the formulary Tier they are assigned and do not apply to your Part D benefits or cost sharing.

Benefits, formulary, pharmacy network, premiums and/or copayments may change on January 1, 2009. You may contact UPREHS for details.
